

2025 FREE RABIES IMMUNIZATION CLINICS



Clinic registration is required. Walk-ins will NOT be accepted

Cat and dog owners are asked to bring proof of previous rabies vaccination in order to receive a certificate valid for three years.

Pet owners without proof of vaccination will receive a certificate valid for one year. Ferrets need annual rabies vaccination regardless of previous vaccinations. By law, all pets must be vaccinated by 4 months of age. All animals must be properly restrained, cats and

ferrets must be in a box or carrier. Dogs must be leashed.
